Rooms and suites

There are 45 suites and junior suites, most of which overlook the Tuileries Garden and have spectacular views of the Paris skyline. On the first floor, our two Presidential Suites offer high ceilings and sumptuous furnishing throughout. Our Prestige Suites - on the second and third

floors of the hotel, have their own beautifully designed living rooms. For those travelling by train, Gare du Nord (TGV /Eurostar, Thalys) is only 15 minutes away and the closest Metro stations - Tuileries or Concorde (Line 1 & 12), are within walking distance. The main airports serving Paris are within easy reach - Roissy-Charles de Gaulle is 40 minutes away, Orly only 30 minutes. Limousines are available for airport pick-up and throughout your stay. If you're driving yourself, parking is available at Place Vendôme.
